Submit your BC Care Aide & Community Health Worker Registry application (the Registry)

• Proof of training from your Educational Institution



The Registry will refer you to Inspire Global Assessments¹ to complete an HCA competency assessment.



Inspire Global Assessments will contact you directly to pay and schedule your assessments.



Complete all HCA competency assessment components:

- Computer-Based Assessment (CBA)
- Simulation Lab Assessment (SLA)



A report will be provided to you after completing the HCA competency assessments and a copy will be sent to the Registry. The Registry will review your report to determine:

a. If you will be directly eligible for registration as an HCA; or

b. If there is a need for additional education that you must complete (e.g., targeted modules, HCA short courses, Upgrade Program or Full HCA Program) before becoming registered.
